COVID-19 and Camp Chickami:

In 2021 (and 2020), Camp Chickami employed mitigation strategies to prevent the potential spread of COVID-19. These included wearing face coverings while indoors or engaged in activities that involved close contact, staggered drop off and pick-up times, and maintaining small camper groups. We had 0 COVID cases at camp in either summer. We will work all off-season to plan for safe operations at Chickami in 2022. We will use guidance from state and local boards of health, placing the health and safety of our campers and staff at the forefront. We anticipate that some of the policies above will change while others remain in place in 2022 as we look to provide the safest and most fun experience for our campers.



Activities:

COVID-19 forced us to adjust much of our traditional Chickami programming during the past 2 summers. In 2022, we are hoping and planning to safely return to our pre-pandemic camp games and activities. This will allow campers to have even more opportunities to have fun trying new things, honing their skills and embracing their creativity with guidance from our Activity Specialists. While COVID-19 guidance will ultimately decide exactly how camp programs are run this summer, we are excited by the possibility of returning to Chickami activities that so many campers and staff know and love.
